

Certificate of RoHS III Compliance

RoHS 3 (EU Directive 2015/863) adds Category 11 (catch-all) products and adds four new restricted substances - all phthalates. The four phthalates are mainly used as insulation plasticizers, and are on the REACH list of SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern). The expanded list for RoHS 3 is thus as follows:•

Cadmium (0.01 %)
Lead (0.1 %)
Mercury (0.1 %)
Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %)
Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

Based on our ingredients lists (or MSDS) submitted by our suppliers, we certify that the substances listed above are not used in the manufacturing of Blue-White products and will not be used in the future. We expect that low trace levels of those substances that may be present as impurities to be within threshold limits.

This statement applies to the following:

- A. All products originally manufactured and released for sale on or after July 1, 2006.
- B. All refurbished, reconditioned or otherwise returned products which exhibit an original manufacture and sold date of July 1, 2006 or later.

This is to certify that to the best of our knowledge, all products manufactured and shipped by Blue-White Industries as of July 01, 2006 do not contain these substances and meet the European Union RoHS Directive 2015/863 for the Reduction of Hazardous Substances.
